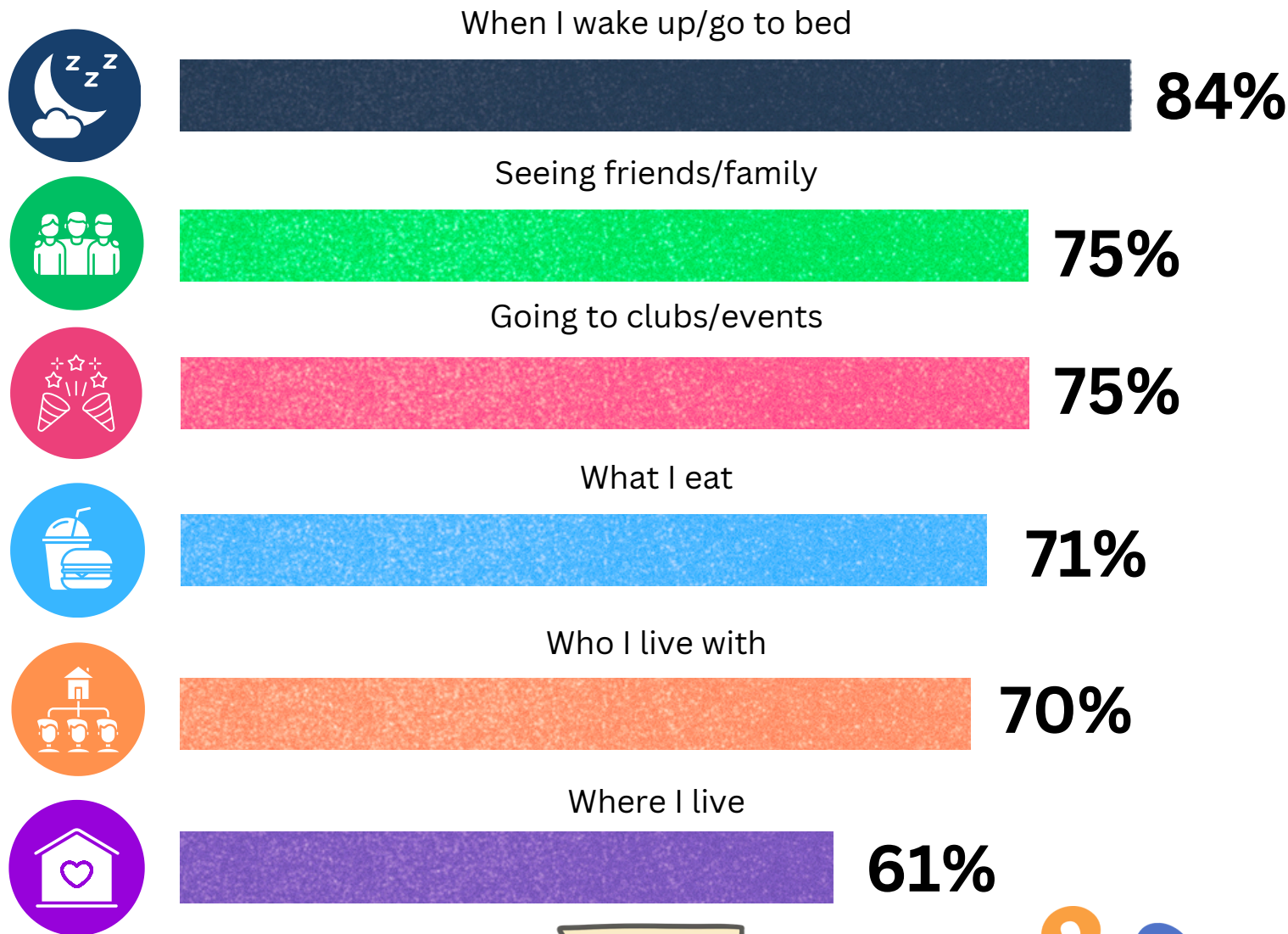


PEOPLE WITH I/DD ARE MAKING DECISIONS EVERY DAY
